

“In real cases an indefinite suspension is given when a case is still pending with the judicial body. As soon as a decision is arrived at, a definite decision is given. I therefore wish to state that my case is not different since it is not pending.”

(iv) Article 64.4.3(b) of the GFA STATUTES as amended on the duties of the Match Review Committee states as follows;

“To recommend to the Executive Committee for their action;

b. suspension for poor officiating;”

(v) This Committee is of the view that the Match Review Committee did not err in recommending indefinite suspension of the appellant to the Executive Committee which under Article 34.6 of the GFA STATUTES has the power to review its own decisions.

(vi) We are satisfied that the Match Review Committee is not in error and this Committee has no reason to interfere with the decision of the aforesaid Committee.

DECISION

The Committee hereby dismisses the appeal brought by the appellant
